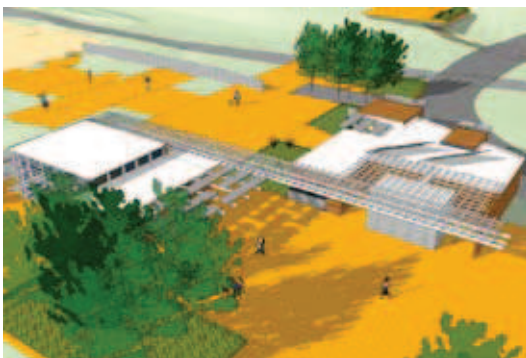
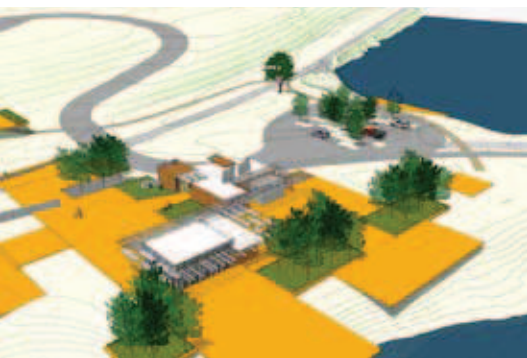
Design Submission by Kevin Moquin, AIA, and Landscape Architect Tony Cowles.
